Paul Bouscaren continued a discussion (from last meeting) on the possibility of accepting credit-cards, explaining both the process and costs involved. After much discussion, it was decided not to be in our best interest at this time. We had hoped for a better turn-out for this discussion, but didn't get it!

Kevin Adams noted we haven't update the Clubs Memorial Plaque in several years and Winnie Jager volunteered to get it done.

Bill Castimore mentioned that the Ag Society (next door) needs some help during the fair.


