## December 15th 2019 at the Conservatory

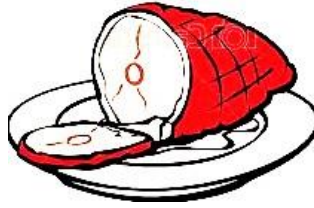
