August 4th-13th

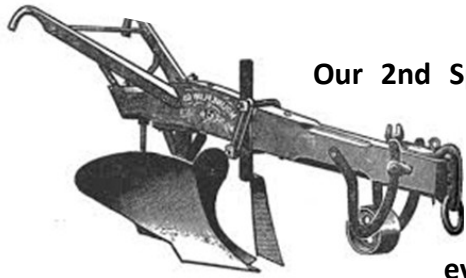
We need volunteers to "prep and work the shed"!
