## **Spring Plow Days Event Green Valley Farms**


997 Route 23N Wantage, NJ 07461

This coal fired steam powered 25 ton tractor was manufactured in 1909 and shipped to Dawson City (Yukon Territory), Canada in 1910. Built by *R. Hornsby & Sons* of Grantham England, it included the Hornsby "Chain Track". This style of undercarriage was patented in England in 1904...considerably after the 1901 American patented *Lombard Undercarriage and Log Hauler* and about the same time as the un-patented *Holt Crawler Tractor*.

Hornsby, a builder of steam, gas and oil fired engines and Ag equipment had previously built crawler tractors powered by the Hornsby/Akroyd Semi-Diesel hot bulb compression-ignition-heavy-oil engine, but this crawler was a one-off special-built unit. It was used to haul coal wagons that supplied Dawson City with coal in the winter. In northwestern Canada oil was scarce and coal was plentiful, so the tractor was powered with a coal fueled steam engine.

Other than the un-patentable sprocket drive, the <u>parallel-link</u> *Hornsby Chain Track* was considerably different and much more complicated than the *Lombard* (and *Holt*) <u>off-set link</u> type crawlers and did not violate the *Lombard* patent. Industrial sprocket-chain drive systems are known to have been in use in China as early as the 10th century, were in use in the French textile industry in the late 1700's and installed on bicycles by the mid-1800's. The *Lombard* and *Hornsby* crawler chain drives were a "big" leap forward in both size and technology. The *Lombard* <u>off-set</u> chain became the predominant style undercarriage in the 20th century and both *Caterpillar* and *Komatsu* introduced <u>parallel-link</u> undercarriages in the 21st century.

In 1914 Hornsby "sold" their track patents to the Holt Manufacturing Company of Stockton, California. Post WWI, Holt and the C. L Best Gas Traction Company, of San Leandro, California (who had purchased the Lombard Flexible Chain Undercarriage patent), went thru a multitude of law suits trying to determine who had the rights to the "crawler track system". This court battle, called "the lawsuit of the century" within the tractor industry, was finally settled in 1925 when Holt and Best joined and became the "Caterpillar Tractor Company"
