The shed was open and we had, by Bill Castimore's count, about 100 guests stop by!

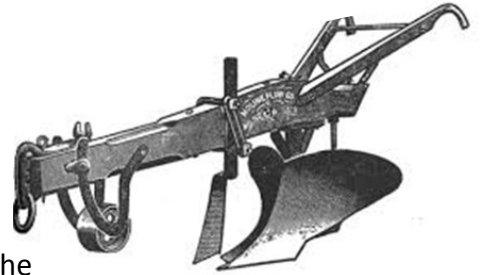


SPRING VINTAGE TRACTOR PLOW DAY
