Dave added that Kathy Cafasso, of the Sussex County Fair, was personally responsible for promoting our club through the New Jersey Herald newspaper, Channel 12 News TV station and other media exposure. Both her and Herald reporter Lori Comstock's, efforts helped greatly in getting increased fairgoer's attention and visitation to our museum/shed.

Chuck mentioned about a possible Fall Plow Day. A definite date and location has not been firmed up and members should stay in-touch with Chuck if interested.

Blace Flatt and Chuck Klim discussed the problem we have with the 1942 Goulds Diaphragm Pump. It needs a new pump diaphragm...cost around \$200.00. The motion was passed to buy it. Also there was some discussion on the Fairbanks-Morse line-shaft engine, which dropped a valve and has a seriously damaged piston.

Paul Havens brought up the Boy Scouts Jamboree coming up on October 5^{4h} thru 6th and they wanted a few engines on display. Paul will be the contact for the event, if anyone wants to attend.



Andrew R. Mackey


